Dear Parents and Carers,

This letter is to inform you of arrangements for the last day of term and the first day back to school after the summer holidays.

- The last day of school for those attending is **Friday 17th of July**.
- The first day for the 2019-2020 academic year, when we return known as The Canterbury Campus, will be **Friday 4th September**. This will not be a full school day. There will a focus on updating the Learning Support Plan so that we can best meet your child’s needs. This will be taking into consideration any summer time developments you want us to be aware of, as well as us updating you both on the school and how it will work during the continued Coronavirus epidemic.

- There may be changes from the government in their guidance over the Summer, so it is vital that you attend the meeting on **4th September** in order to be able to best support your child and the school.
